



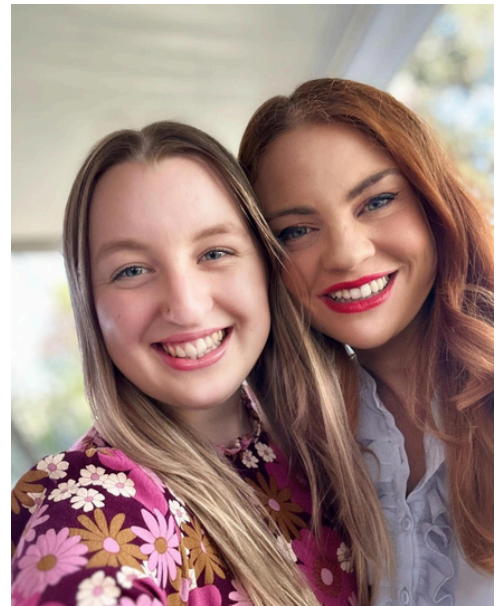

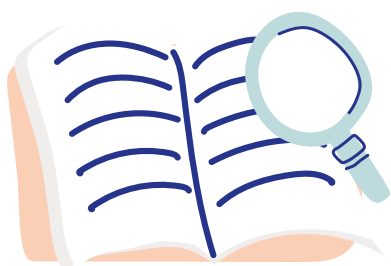
Podcast Episode: Neurodiversity and Chronic Illness
